The Church of Saint Ann, in celebration of the International Day of Peace, is hosting an Interfaith Peace Prayer Vigil on Thursday, September 21 at 7:00 p.m. in the church.

Joining together in prayer and unity with people of all faiths, races and cultures, the prayer observance for peace is meant to demonstrate the power of prayer in promoting peace and in building unity with others to breakdown divisions that can led to conflict.

In his message for the celebration of the 50th World Day of Peace in December of 2016, Pope Francis remarked, “All of us want peace. Many people build it day by day through small gestures and acts; many of them are suffering, yet patiently persevere in their efforts to be peacemakers.

In 2017, may we dedicate ourselves prayerfully and actively to banishing violence from our hearts, words and deeds, and to becoming nonviolent people and to building nonviolent communities that care for our common home. Nothing is impossible if we turn to God in prayer. Everyone can be an artisan of peace”.
