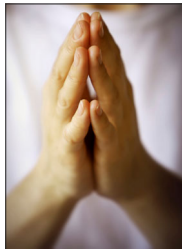
We are happy, that in this small way, you will be united with each of us as we travel. We ask that you pray for all of us, connecting you to our pilgrimage.
