

# Year of the Eucharist Reflection

After his conversion to the faith, St. Hilary of Poitiers (c. 310-367) lent all of his intellectual powers to the theological controversies of the fourth century. In the following passage, he warns Christians against rash interpretations of sacred doctrine and exhorts them to discern the true meaning of Scripture. Applying this nuanced view to the Bread of Life discourse, St. Hilary underscores its unmistakable meaning: Christ gives Himself to man so that man might be wholly united to Him.

When we speak of the things of God, our words should not be used in a merely human or worldly sense, nor should we employ impetuous or imprudent speech. One should expunge the perversity of foreign and impious interpretations from pure and heavenly sayings. Let us read what is written and understand what we read, and then fulfill the duties of a perfect faith.

Now, we would be speaking foolishly and impiously by claiming that Christ's nature dwells within us, unless we had learned it from Him. For He Himself said, "My flesh is truly food and my blood is truly drink. Whoever eats my flesh, and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him" [John 6:56]. He leaves no room for ambiguity regarding the truth of the flesh and blood. And once these things are accepted and received, they prove that we are in Christ, and that Christ is in us. And is this not the truth?

Wednesday, May 29th


The bus will depart SDTK parking lot at 8:30 AM, arrive at the shrine by 10:00 AM and return about 3:30 PM.
