






Year of the Eucharist Reflection

St. Óscar Romero (1917-1980) served as the archbishop of San Salvador until his death in 1980, when he was fatally shot while celebrating Holy Mass. While many priests first viewed Oscar as a bookish man who would not make waves in the civil strife plaguing the country, his devotion to the Eucharist impelled him to seek peace on behalf of warring factions. Such efforts won him the hatred of both camps, resulting in his death. His words remain a sublime reminder that the Eucharist allows man to look back to Calvary, while gazing forward to the eschatological hope of its fulfillment in heaven.

The eucharist makes us look back to Calvary twenty centuries ago and beyond that to Moses and the old covenant, an incomparable horizon of history. But it also looks ahead to the future, to the eternal, eschatological, and definitive horizon that presents itself as a demanding ideal to all political systems, to all social struggles, to all those concerned for the earth. The church does not ignore the earth, but in the eucharist it says to all who work on earth: look beyond. Each time the Victim is lifted up at Mass, Christ's call is heard: "Until we drink it anew in my Father's kingdom." And the people reply: "Come, Lord Jesus." There is a hope. They are a people that march to encounter the Lord. Death is not the end. Death is the opening of eternity's portal. That is why I say: all the blood, all the dead, all the mysteries of iniquity and sin, all the tortures, all those dungeons of our security forces, where unfortunately many persons slowly die, do not mean they are lost forever.

ACA Ministry Spotlight: Evangelization

Evangelization is the primary mission of the Church. Diocesan and parish initiatives provide opportunities to grow in faith and into intimate union with God. An expansive array of ministry programs make the spiritual works of mercy a reality for families at all stages of life in the parishes and on a diocesan level. Throughout the diocese last year we had 5,970 Baptisms, 5,834 Funerals, and 1,311 Marriages.

Our outreach for youth, the aging, family life, campus life and ministry among Catholics enrich the everyday and spiritual lives of over 640,000 parishioners.

Your support makes it possible for the Diocese to prepare leaders at the parish level who teach over 32,000 Religious Education students each year and bring hundreds of men and women annually into full-initiation within the Catholic Faith.

Last year, 395 Catechumens, 556 Candidates (Non-Catholics and Catholics completing initiation) were welcomed in. In addition, there were 5,741 First Communicants and 6,029 Confirmandi throughout the diocese.






