#### YEAR OF THE EUCHARIST REFLECTION

In his commentary on the Gospel of John, St. Gaudentius (d. 410) comments on Christ's words, "I am the true vine" (John 15:1). Noting the prophetic symbolism of wine in Genesis, ("He will wash his robe in wine and his garment in blood," Gen 49:11), St. Gaudentius here argues that this figure is fulfilled upon the cross of Calvary. In no uncertain terms, St. Gaudentius professes the ancient faith of the Church, affirming that the Eucharistic wine becomes the blood of Christ.

"In this truth in which we live, one died for all and feeds all the individual churches by His immolation in the Mystery of the bread and wine. Having been believed, He gives life to them. Having been consecrated, He sanctifies those who are consecrating. This is the flesh of the lamb, and this, the blood. For the Bread who descends from heaven says, "the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh" [John 6:51].

He rightly expresses His blood under the form of wine when He says in the gospel, "I am the true vine" [John 15:1]. He declares that wine is His blood, since it is offered in the form of His Passion. The blessed patriarch Jacob prophesied concerning Christ: "He will wash his robe in wine and his garment in blood" [Gen 49:11]. Indeed, He was to cover the robe of our body, His garment, with His own blood. Thus, He is the Creator and Lord of nature who produced bread from the earth, and brought about His own body from bread, because He can and promises to do so. He who made wine from water also made His blood from wine."

#### 2024 CHRISTMAS FESTIVAL COMMITTEE VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO PLAN THIS FESTIVAL


