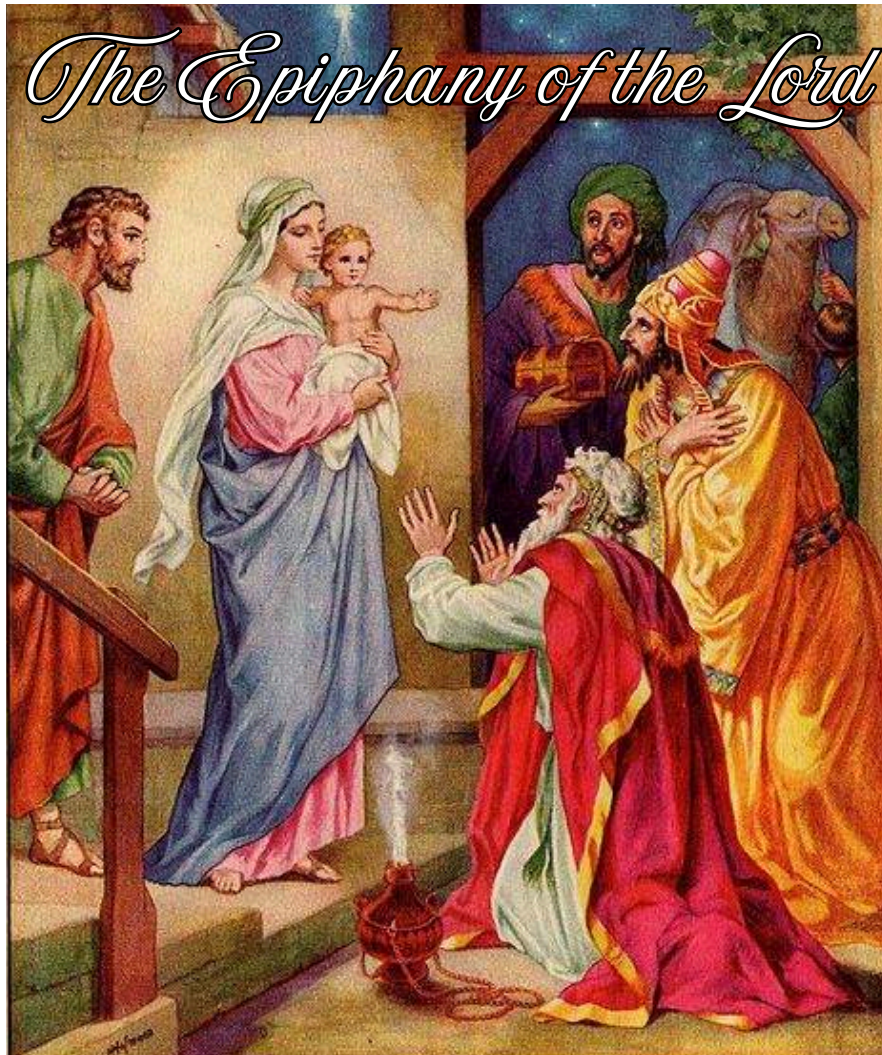

Receiving the Eucharist on the Tongue

The practice of receiving the Eucharist directly on the tongue rather than in the hand reflects a profound reverence for the real presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. This tradition is rooted in both the writings of the Church Fathers and the teachings of various popes.

St. Cyril of Jerusalem, Church Father, advised the faithful to treat the Eucharist with utmost care, describing a method of receiving it in the hand but with great caution (Mystagogical Catecheses 5.21). However, this early practice was later discouraged due to concerns about irreverence and potential loss of particles of the Host. By the 5th and 6th centuries, the norm in the West shifted to reception on the tongue to safeguard the sacred species.

Additionally, Pope St. Gregory the Great (590–604) emphasized the sanctity of the Eucharist, supporting practices that heightened reverence. More recently, Pope St. John Paul II in *Dominicae Cenae* (1980) expressed concern about diminishing Eucharistic reverence and emphasized that receiving on the tongue better protects the sacred species and highlights its sublime mystery. Pope Benedict XVI, in his liturgies, frequently administered Communion on the tongue to emphasize reverence and the universal tradition of the Church.

Ultimately, the preference for receiving the Eucharist on the tongue highlights the Church’s desire to foster awe and protect the sacredness of Christ’s presence. While the Church permits Communion in the hand, this must always be done with profound care and devotion.


