



## **Year of the Eucharist Reflection**

St. Cyril (378-444) was the archbishop of Alexandria and the leading voice of orthodoxy against the errors of Nestorius. Whereas Nestorius separated Christ's two natures so as to posit two persons (prosopon) in Christ, Cyril articulated the Church's faith in the unity of Christ. Christ thus possesses two natures, divine and human, that are united in His one divine person. According to the orthodox view, the only subject of the humanity of Christ—and by extension the Eucharist— is the divine person of the Son. For this reason, the humanity of Christ and the Eucharist are worthy of adoration.

He clearly says, "this is my body" and "this is my blood" [Matt 26:26, 28] that you may not think the appearances are only a figure, but that the proffered gifts we partake in are, in fact, transformed into the body and blood of Christ in accordance with the truth of God who is ineffable and omnipotent. And by receiving them, we receive into ourselves the life-giving and sanctifying power of Christ. For through the Holy Spirit, He had to be mingled in a way fitting for God to be in us; dwelling within us bodily by His holy flesh and precious blood. We have these things as a life-giving blessing under bread and wine that we may not grow faint when beholding the flesh and blood being offered on the sacred tables of the churches. Because God wanted to assist us in our weaknesses, He imparted the power of life to the gifts, and transformed them to contain the effects of His life. Do not doubt that this is true, because He clearly said, "this is my body" and "this is my blood" [Matt 26:26, 28]. Rather, receive the Savior's saying by faith, because it is true and no lie.


