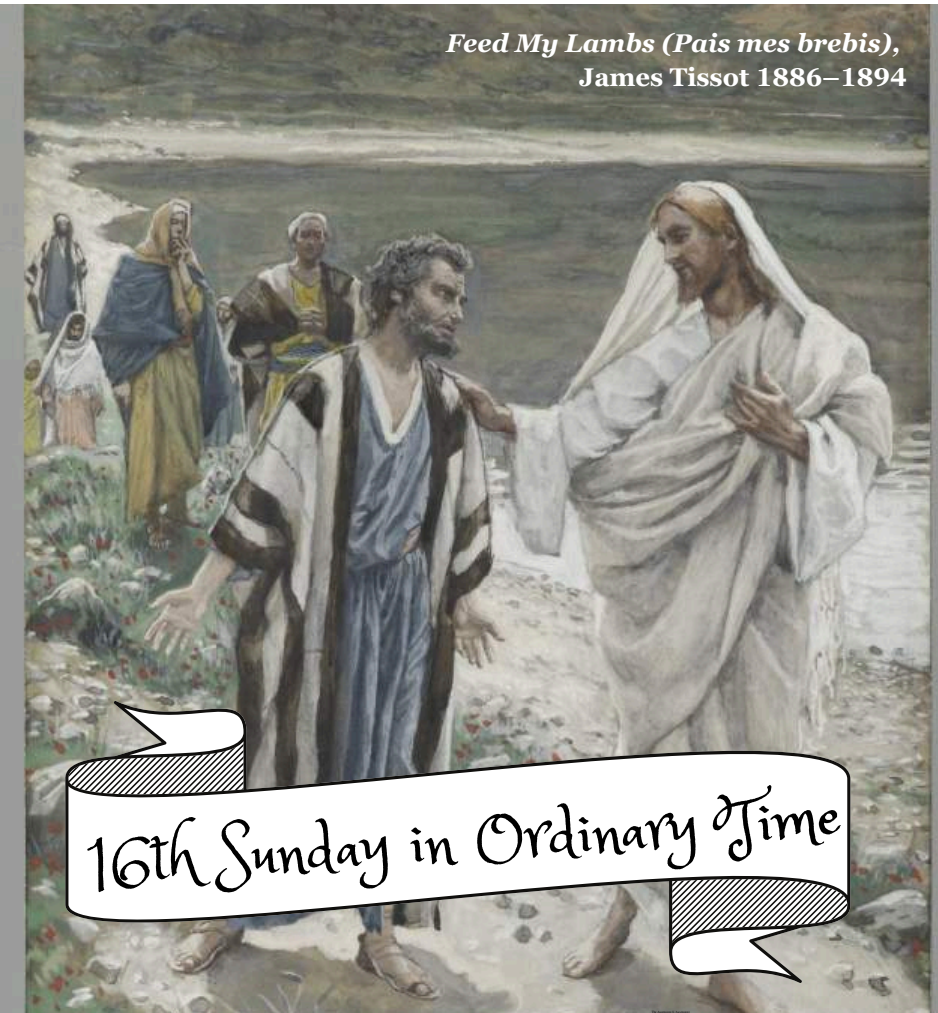

Year of the Eucharist Reflection

On the feast of St. Thomas the Apostle, the Church remembers the confession of him who required sight to believe. In this reading, St. John Chrysostom (349-407) explains that Christians who make similar demands are met by Christ in the Eucharist. Not only does the Blessed Sacrament allow man to draw near to Christ as Thomas had, but it makes possible a union otherwise unattainable. The Eucharist is the door to heaven and the great means of intimate union between God and man.

“Let His word be stronger than our own reasonings and sight. And this we practice in regard to the Mysteries, not focusing on the things we see before us, but holding fast to His words. His word cannot deceive, but our senses can easily be deceived. God has never failed, yet our senses have been overturned many times. Since He says, "this is my body" [Matt 26:26], let us be persuaded, believe, and look on with spiritual vision. For, Christ has delivered nothing to us that can be seen with the senses, but rather metaphysical realities in observable things. So also in baptism: the gift comes through the sensible element of water, but what is produced is metaphysical, i.e., birth and regeneration. If you did not have a body, He would have given you the gifts in bare reality without physical form. But since the soul is bound up with the body, He gives you metaphysical realities in physical things. So many say, "I would like to see His form, His distinctive appearance, His clothes, His sandals." Look, you do see him, you touch him, you eat him. Yes, you desire to see His garments, but He gives you Himself; not only to see, but to be touched, eaten, and received within. Let no one approach staggering nor dissolute; rather, all should be inflamed, full of zeal, and fully awake. If the Jews stood ready with their sandals and staff in hand, eating with haste, how much more should we be sober and disciplined. They were about to enter Israel and walked with a roadmap, but we are about to journey to heaven.”
