

YEAR OF THE EUCHARIST REFLECTION

St. Chromatis (d. 406), bishop of Aquilia, was an early theologian who encouraged the scholastic pursuits of his fellow bishops. In his treatise on the Gospel of St. Matthew, St. Chromatius offers a Bucha-ristic vision of the Lord's Prayer and its petition, "give us this day our daily bread." Referencing the Bread of Life discourse and St. Paul's ad. monitions concerning Holy Communion, St. Chromatius emphasizes that this petition is directed toward reception of the Eucharist. He thus teaches that Christians must remain within the Mystical Body by fitting conduct and worthy reception of the Eucharist.

"Give us today our daily bread" [Matt 6:11] ... We are commanded in a spiritual sense to seek daily bread, that is, that heavenly and spiritual bread we daily receive to heal the soul, and as hope of eternal salvation. The Lord says in the Gospel, "The bread from heaven is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world" [John 6:50, 52]. And we are urged to ask for this bread daily, that is, that we may be worthy to receive the bread of the body of the Lord while His mercy is present. For the Apostle says: "Let a man test himself and thus let him eat from the bread of the Lord and drink the cup" [1 Cor 11:28], and again, "who-ever eats the bread of the Lord unworthily and drinks the cup will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord" [1 Cor 11:29). For this reason, we ought always to strive to pray worthily that we may be counted fit to receive this heavenly bread and not be separated from the body of the Lord by some lurking sin.

Please pray for the sick in our parish and those grieving the loss of a loved one.


THE IGNATIAN VOLUNTEER CORPS: A RETIREMENT COMMITMENT THAT MAKES A DIFFERENCE
