### YEAR OF THE EUCHARIST REFLECTION

In the Divine Liturgy of St. James, the most ancient Eastern liturgy still in use, the priest intones the following prayer between the words of institution ("this is my body") and the epiclesis. The epiclesis is the invocation of the Holy Spirit, which the Church in the East views as the central act of consecration. Here, the text begins with "remember" corresponding with the "anamnesis" of the Latin rite. The priest thus recalls the saving work of Christ and pleads for mercy in view of the Holy Sacrifice at hand.

The priest: "We sinners remember His life-giving Passion, His saving cross, His death, and Resurrection on the third day from the dead, His ascent into heaven and His sitting at the right hand of his God and Father, and His glorious and fearful second coming, when He will render to each one his due in accord with his works. Master, we offer You this awesome and unbloody sacrifice that You may deal with us not according to our sins, nor reward us according to our iniquities. Please deal with us according to Your gentle and ineffable love for mankind, because by overcoming and wiping away the written ordinance against us by Your mercies, You graciously granted us your heavenly and eternal gifts which eye has not seen, nor ear heard. The things You have prepared for those who love You have not even entered into the human heart. Do not reject Your people on my account, nor on account of my sins, O Lord, Lover of Mankind."




