A new school year is right around the corner. We are excited to start the new year and share our Catholic faith's richness with your child and you.

Registration will begin on Wednesday, July 17, 2024, and continue until August 16, which qualifies for a pre-pay discount of \$50 per family.

<u>Grades 1 to 4</u> will attend Tuesday sessions from 4:30 pm to 6:00 pm, beginning September 17, 2024, and running through until April 1, 2025.

<u>Grades 5 to 7</u> will attend Wednesday sessions from 4:30 pm to 6:00 pm, beginning September 18, 2024, and running through until April 2, 2025.

<u>Confirmation 8th grade</u> - The second year of Confirmation preparation consists of weekly sessions in the Youth Hall. <u>Class time is on Wednesdays from 4:30 – 6:00 pm</u>. This year, we will utilize Purpose, an interactive curriculum from Life Teen. Purpose is a transformative approach to confirmation. The curriculum consists of 22 sessions focusing on evangelizing young people and accompanying them as they become disciples. The curriculum addresses three big questions, "Why believe in God?" "Why trust Jesus?" and "Why be a part of the Church?" Our Confirmation program offers opportunities to grow in the Christian faith and learn from the richness of Catholic life. Participation in Sunday mass, the 8th-grade retreat, and community service are all part of the curriculum.

As a reminder, we are not requiring learners and their families to attend Family Catechesis gatherings or events. We will still be offering some throughout the year for those families interested.
