

YEAR OF THE EUCHARISTIC REFLECTION

St. John Chrysostom (349-407) expressed the Real Presence and power of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament as clearly as any Church Father. Born in Antioch, St. John became Patriarch of Constantinople in 397, and there remained until his exile and death in 407. The following reading comes from his treatise On the Priesthood, wherein he describes the majesty of the Divine Liturgy. Shaking his readers from any complacency, St. John recalls that the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass grants man vision of the heavenly liturgy and draws him into its celestial feast.

"When you see the Lord sacrificed and lying there, and the priest standing and praying over the sacrifice with all those who have become stained with that precious blood, do you think you are still among men and standing on earth? Are you not rather transported immediately into heaven? Once you cast aside every carnal thought of your soul, do you not see the things in heaven with a transparent soul and pure mind? O what a marvel! O the love of God for humanity! He who sits on high with the Father is at that hour in the hands of all, and gives Himself to those who desire to embrace and enfold Him. Now, accomplish this all through the eyes of faith!"
