YEAR OF THE EUCHARIST REFLECTION

In the following sermon, St. Caesarius of Arles (c. 468-542) identifies the Liturgy of the Eucharist as the heart of the Mass. While the Liturgy of the Word is not unimportant, Caesarius notes that Christ is present in a singular and substantial way in the Eucharist. He therefore cautions his hearers not to leave Mass before this central act is complete.

"Brothers, I ask that you accept our humble suggestion with patience and a willing spirit.

If you are in diligent attendance, you know that the Mass is not complete when the sacred readings are recited in church, but when the gifts are offered and the body and blood of the Lord is consecrated. For the readings - whether those of the prophets, the apostles, or the gospels - you can read in your own homes, or hear others read them. But you cannot witness the consecration of the body and blood of Christ anywhere else than in the house of God.

Therefore, whoever wants to celebrate Mass with a pure heart, and thereby profit in soul, ought to remain in church until the Lord's Prayer is said and the benediction is given, prostrating oneself with a penitent heart."




